Onwards we then travel to the charming town of Hoi An, discovering the stunning rich culture, vibrant markets and heritage. We take a peaceful cruise along the **Thu Bon River**, offering stunning views of Hoi An's old quarters, and visit one of the town's famous **lantern workshops**, where we learn to craft our own colorful lanterns and not forgetting our chance to really indulge in local culinary culture with a local cooking class after a market tour with the Executive Chef/Trainer, on a riverside setting — the perfect backdrop to enjoy a meal you just learned to cook.

Our journey continues south to Ho Chi Minh City, formally known as Saigon, Vietnams most populist city and the economic heart of the country. The city draws together old and new and from our boutique accommodation at the **Silverland May Hotel**, we journey back in time to the elegance of 1930's Vietnam, with a touch of timeless French Indochina charm. From here, we visit some of the most important sites related to the Vietnam War, including the **Cu Chi Tunnels**, and the **War Remnants Museum**, gaining insight into Vietnam's wartime history.

Our tour would not be complete without a visit to the **Mekong Delta**, where we cruise in style on a luxury **sampan**, taking in the sights of rural life along the river. We also visit a local coconut industry, where nothing goes to waste, providing a hands-on experience of local craftsmanship.

Upon arrival in Hanoi, we will be welcomed by our local Englishspeaking guide and head for our first Vietnamese lunch in a local restaurant enroute to the hotel. After lunch, we transfer to the hotel which will be our home for the next three nights.

Our hotel is the 4* Aira Boutique Hotel & Spa nestled in the lush treelined charming diplomatic Tran Phu Street, which is merely a few steps from the quaint Hanoi Old Quarter, making it a very convenient location for exploring the local markets. The hotels Essencia Spa using ancient healing modalities such as Himalayan Salt Stone Treatment and Ancient Fire Acupuncture for those wanting some pampering.

The rest of the day is free to relax prior to re-gathering for our Welcome Dinner which will set the scene for the coming days.

Discover the History and Culture of Hanoi

Today, we embark on a full-day tour to explore the rich history and culture of Hanoi. Our day begins with a visit to the imposing Ho **Chi Minh Mausoleum**, followed by a tour of his tranquil wooden stilt house and the iconic One Pillar Pagoda. We then delve into Vietnam's intellectual heritage at the Temple of Literature, the country's first university, where we learn about its deep-rooted connection to Confucian philosophy.

After enjoying lunch together, we continue to the peaceful **Hoan Kiem Lake** and the **Ngoc Son Temple**, before visiting a traditional Vietnamese "long house," providing a glimpse into ancient ways of life. To immerse ourselves in the local culture, we'll take a one-hour cyclo tour through the narrow streets of Hanoi's bustling Old Quarter, offering an authentic experience of the city's timeless charm and traditional Vietnamese architecture.

We conclude the day with a delightful dinner at a local restaurant, savouring the flavours of Vietnamese cuisine.

FRI 26 Ho Chi Minh City to Mekong Delta


Lunch is at the iconic **Le Longanier Restaurant**, nestled in a tropical garden, providing a perfect setting to relax and enjoy the local cuisine.
